It is with great joy and thanksgiving to our Lord that we send out this News Letter to you. Firstly an update on Cisca's condition. Last week Cisca completed the sixth and last three-day series of her Oncologist's ordered Chemo treatments. As I'm sure you all know, Chemo treatment is anything but pleasant. Generally it makes the recipient very sick. This unfortunately has been true for Cisca. However, we are happy to report that the cancer has been very greatly reduced, seemingly almost to nothing. For this we thank the Lord. In the future Cisca will be put on a maintenance program of immuno therapy once every three weeks. We trust that her strength will start to return and she will be able to live a normal life and we can once again resume our ministry/mission trips together.

As I mentioned in our last News Letter I was scheduled to minister in Brazil during the month of September, unfortunately, I had to cancel that ministry trip due to Cisca's illness.

This December I have been invited back to Ndola, Zambia. I will be ministering for six days at Trinity Embassy International Church, the last day of which will be the graduation ceremony. The senior pastor there is Apostle John Chellah, he is assisted by his brother Ernest. Ernest is the principal of the Bible College. We are delighted that this is the third year they have used our "All The World Missions" Bible College curriculum. This year twenty-nine students will be graduating. In this we rejoice greatly that the Word of God is being taught and is going out into the communities. I am greatly looking forward to being in Zambia again and meeting with these precious people of God.

At this point I am not sure if anyone will accompany me to Zambia in December 2019. I am praying that if the Lord wills He will provide a Christian Brother to travel with me.

Travel across the world is never cheap and tending to get more and more expensive. Therefore, if any of you feel that you could help financially towards expenses for this trip, it will be greatly appreciated.

As always, I am believing and expecting God to do great things during this period of ministry. I ask you to pray for me that first and foremost souls will be saved, also for a great move of the Holy Spirit that His mighty gifts will be in operation during my time in Zambia.
